Approximately 1 in 10 people who live in Spain is of foreign origin.



02

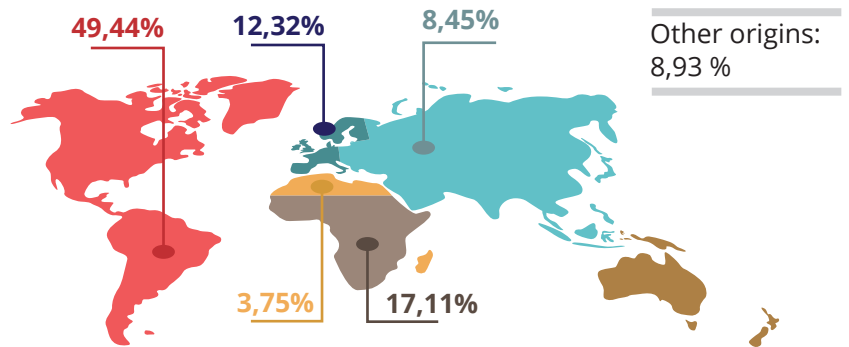
However, nearly 24% of people with HIV in Spain are of foreign origin.

Approximately one third of new cases of HIV in 2013 was in people of foreign origin.

Almost 50% of new cases diagnosed in immigrants were in people from Latin America.

Sexual intercourse between men was the main channel of HIV transmission in men from Western Europe and Latin America

Sexual intercourse between people of a different sex was the main channel of HIV transmission in people from Sub-Saharan Africa
