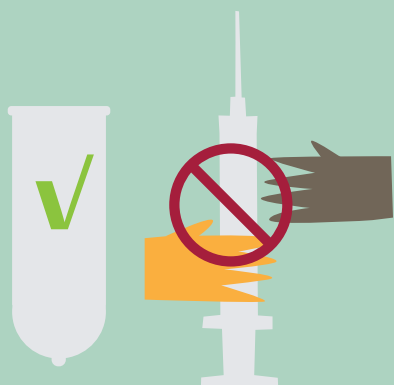


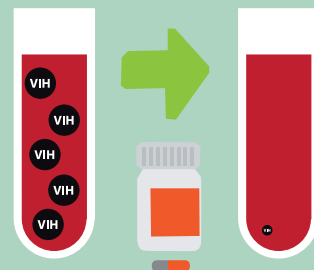

1 HIV is not an infection that spreads easily as it can only be transmitted from person to person through sex without a condom or through the blood.



2 HIV does not therefore spread when living alongside someone in acts such as sharing a bed, food or using the same sink. Neither does it spread by hugging, kissing or holding hands with an infected person nor through mosquito bites.



3 If a person with HIV is taking his or her treatment properly, the chances of the virus spreading decreases a great deal and in some cases is reduced nearly to zero.



4 To prevent transmission through the blood it is important not to share syringes or personal utensils that are sharp or may contain the remains of blood.



5 Living alongside people with HIV therefore should not require special preventive measures or lead to discrimination of any kind.
